The term "Rashism (rashyzm)", developed by Doctor of Pedagogical Sciences and Professor Mykola Ivanovych Piddiachy, was posted on the social media platform Facebook and on the website of the electronic library of the National Academy of Pedagogical Sciences of Ukraine on April 24, 2022 (URL: https://lib.iitta.gov.ua/730502/). On May 12, 2022, the term was recommended for full and frequent use by journalists and media organizations by the Committee on Humanitarian and Information Policy of the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine (URL: https://www.facebook.com/verkhovna.rada.ukraine/posts/pfbid02bu28dEkgymp3g2PH857KfS7vkVHe2d1HSnUDaTNxzt7acNvUoArqEmEb61sms1LA1).

To foster a deeper understanding of the threat this phenomenon poses to civilization and the necessity of sustained efforts and resource mobilization for its eradication, the term has been refined and translated into the following languages: English, Mandarin Chinese, Hindi, Spanish, French, Arabic, Bengali, Portuguese, Indonesian, Urdu, German, Polish, Italian, Japanese, and Russian.

Rashism (rashyzm) is an imperial, authoritarian-totalitarian political regime in the Russian Federation (Russia), created by the dictator-president V. Putin with the support of 83% of the Russian population (according to the Russian sociological agency Levada Center, March 24–30, 2022). By strictly regulating the operations of state and societal institutions, as well as private life, the Russian regime has deprived them of autonomy in political, economic, cultural, educational, religious, and other spheres of activity.

Since the beginning of the 21st century, rashists have developed and systematically carried out a covert genocide of the Ukrainian people, characterized by all the hallmarks of state terrorism. This has been accompanied by an unprecedented aggressive and militaristic policy incorporating elements of fascism, Nazism, chauvinism, cyber warfare, and an egotistical attitude toward global civilization. This justifies designating Russia as a "Terrorist State of the Russian Federation" (TSRF).

The broad use of the term "rashism" by Ukrainians and its international dissemination emerged amidst the deep-rooted hatred of Ukraine's democratic society toward authoritarian-totalitarian Russia and those supporting the regime. These individuals made the decision to launch the unprovoked war against Ukraine and:

- 1. Provide political, informational-propaganda, military, resource, and technological support.
- 2. Endorse the chauvinistic policies formulated by Russian ideologists toward Ukrainians and other peoples, nations, and ethnic groups.
- 3. Exploit natural resources (oil, gas, diamonds, gold, and other minerals) to organize and execute acts of terrorism. A significant portion of the capital generated from resource sales was directed by rashists (adherents of rashism) to ensure the dynamic development of the military-industrial complex, enabling the possession of a substantial arsenal of all types of weaponry.

The key features of rashism in contemporary conditions are as follows:

- 1. Absence of a comprehensive development strategy for Russia and its people, including the lack of a civilizational paradigm, a national idea, motivation, patriotism, or a socio-economic concept.
- 2. The use of methodologies and technologies by "Kremlin ideologists" to form a distorted consciousness among Russians and the global population, aimed at twisting the evolutionarily established objective civilizational life space (both historical and modern dimensions).
- 3. The lack of freedom as a fundamental trait of personality among most Russians, depriving them of the ability to choose and manage their existence based on their desires, interests, and goals, rooted in knowledge of the surrounding reality obtained through perception and understanding.
- 4. Encroachment on the state sovereignty and territorial integrity of Ukraine and neighboring countries.
- 5. Concealment of terrorist intentions by the Kremlin's ruling elite toward Ukraine and its people.
- 6. Declaration of policies aimed at de-Ukrainization, demilitarization, denazification, and neutralization of Ukrainians.
- 7. Genocide against Ukrainians, legally documented by Ukrainian and international institutions.
 - 8. Production of misanthropic ideology.
- 9. Possession of modern military equipment and destructive technologies to pursue a forceful approach in achieving stated objectives.
 - 10. Hybrid warfare tactics.
- 11. Use of deceptive peace negotiation methods during the war to deliver devastating blows to Ukraine and its population.
- 12. Deployment of Russian troops in Belarus and the use of its territory to launch attacks on Ukraine.
- 13. Violation of agreements and protocols of the Geneva Convention, among others.

It should be noted that the essence of Russia and its people has been formed over centuries. Its conduct toward states, societies, and cultures throughout history has been characterized by the



most talented individuals who consciously and boldly described the "moral" and life principles, aggressiveness, and relentless, uncompromising nature of achieving selfish interests at any cost.

The gradual degradation of Russia over time has been highlighted not only by Ukrainian and foreign public, cultural, and political figures, classic authors, philosophers, political scientists, and poets but also by Russians themselves:

At the same time, a group of supporters of the covert Russian terrorist policy began to form from 2000, both domestically and internationally. These relations were managed through material resources obtained from the sale of natural resources by state institutions, oligarchs, and private entities at preferential prices, aimed at fostering loyalty to Russian policy. Supporters of Russian policy ranged from heads of states, unable to set civilizational priorities, to politicians, businessmen, officials, and functionaries interested in boosting economic indicators through Russian energy and material resources. This allowed Russia to have a significant number of covert "managers" to serve the selfish needs of the ruling elite and their allies, as well as to lobby for interests in regional and global state, commercial, and public institutions (UN, EU, Council of Europe, NATO, transnational companies, and business entities, etc.).

Under the pretext of denazification. demilitarization, and the protection of the interests of the Russian-speaking population in Ukraine, Ukrainians and infrastructure were destroyed with particular cruelty by the "orcs" (a derogatory term for Russian occupiers, used after Russia's invasion of Ukraine on February 24, 2022) across much of Ukraine (Borodyanka, Bucha, Mariupol, Melitopol, Kharkiv, Izium, Chernihiv, and others). confirms that the goal of Russia's unprovoked full-scale invasion was to destroy Ukrainian identity and annex Ukrainian territories.

It should be noted that despite appeals from religious leaders, churches, and representatives of global institutions, dictator V. Putin continues to

escalate his aggression with increasing brutality, involving his "oprichniks," "cannibalistic" elites, and countries and groups loyal to his Russian fascist agenda. Condemning the war against Ukraine, they noted in their addresses:

I appeal to the international community and all religious leaders worldwide, calling for support for Ukraine and urging Russia and Belarus to immediately cease their aggression. I ask this of all people of good will and conscience.

Those who have initiated and are leading the aggressive war against Ukraine must know that, according to both God's law and human law, they are murderers and criminals. For their crime, they will answer before the Almighty and humanity, not escaping condemnation and punishment.

As your Primate, I stand with you, fulfilling my duties. As events develop, I will keep you informed.

"Do not be afraid; stand firm, and you will see the deliverance the Lord will bring you today [...]; the Lord will fight for you; you need only to be still" (Exodus 14:13-14).

Ukrainians are a peace-loving people, yet strong in spirit and faith. We strongly urge Russia to abandon its chosen path of violence and aggression. Russian leaders must bear full responsibility for the consequences of their actions. Russia will pay a very high economic and political price. NATO will maintain close coordination with relevant stakeholders and other international organizations, including the EU.

Russia's actions pose a serious threat to Euro-Atlantic security and will have geostrategic consequences. NATO will continue to take all necessary measures to ensure the security and defense of all Allies" (URL: https://www.nato.int/cps/en/natohq/official_texts_192404.htm?selectedLocale=en, URL:

The UN Security Council adopted a statement:

"The Security Council expresses its deep concern regarding the maintenance of peace and security in Ukraine... The UN General Assembly, on March 2, 2022, adopted a resolution:

"The General Assembly demands that the Russian Federation immediately cease its use of force against Ukraine and refrain from any unlawful threats or use of force against any UN member state... We further demand that the Russian Federation immediately, fully, and unconditionally withdraw all its armed forces from the territory of Ukraine within its internationally recognized borders" (URL: https://www.pravda.com.ua/news/2022/03/2/7327544/).

The European Union condemns in the strongest possible terms the latest escalation by Russia in its illegal, unprovoked, and unjustified aggression against Ukraine. Russia's actions in Ukraine continue to pose a grave threat to peace and security in Europe and globally, with significant worldwide repercussions, including worsening food insecurity and rising energy prices. We remain steadfast in our commitment to supporting Ukraine's defense efforts by providing military equipment for as long as necessary.

The EU remains unwavering in its support for Ukraine's independence, sovereignty, and territorial integrity. It demands that Russia immediately, fully, and unconditionally withdraw all its troops and military equipment from the entire territory of Ukraine within its internationally recognized borders (URL: https://tinyurl.com/3pada7zb).

It is particularly significant that even the appeal of Metropolitan Onufriy, Primate of the Ukrainian Orthodox Church of the Moscow Patriarchate, on February 24, 2022, was ignored by dictator Vladimir Putin:

"As the Primate of the Ukrainian Orthodox Church, I address you and all citizens of Ukraine. A great tragedy has unfolded. Regrettably, Russia has initiated military actions against Ukraine. In this decisive moment, I urge everyone to remain calm, to show courage, and to demonstrate love for your Homeland and for one another. Above all, I call upon you to intensify your penitential prayers for Ukraine, for our military, and for our people. I also implore you to set aside mutual quarrels and misunderstandings and to unite in love for God and our Homeland.

In this tragic time, we extend our deepest love and unwavering support to our soldiers, who vigilantly stand guard, protect, and defend our land and our people. May God bless them and keep them safe!

While defending the sovereignty and territorial integrity of Ukraine, we also appeal to the President of Russia, urging an immediate end to this fratricidal war. The Ukrainian and Russian peoples share a common spiritual heritage from the baptismal font of the Dnipro River. A war between these nations mirrors the sin of Cain, who, driven by envy, took the life of his own brother. Such a war finds no justification before either God or humanity.

I call on everyone to embrace common sense, which guides us to resolve earthly conflicts through mutual dialogue and understanding. I earnestly hope that God will forgive our sins and that His peace will reign over our land and throughout the world!" (URL:

Representatives of political parties, governmental structures, and societal institutions of the Russian Federation, who accepted substantial remuneration to serve the Rashist policies of dictator Vladimir Putin, included:

- Chairman of the State Duma Vyacheslav Volodin and deputies,
- Chairwoman of the Federation Council Valentina Matviyenko,
- Prime Minister Mikhail Mishustin and government officials,
- Minister of Defense Sergei Shoigu and the military,
- Director of the Federal Security Service (FSB) Alexander Bortnikov and security service personnel,
- Deputy Chairman of the Security Council Dmitry Medvedev,
- Political parties and movements,
- Journalists, cultural figures, and artists, among others.

In executing Rashist policies, a pivotal role was played by oligarchs loyal to Putin, who amassed their wealth through his patronage. Acting under his direct orders, they promptly mobilized all available resources to further his agenda.

For terrorism against the Ukrainian people and encroachment on Ukraine's territorial integrity, dictator Vladimir Putin has been declared a war criminal by world leaders, led by U.S. President Joe Biden. The crimes committed by Putin and his 'oprichniks' against Ukrainians and humanity are being addressed in Ukrainian and international tribunals and courts and will forever be etched in world history.

The realization of the impending global catastrophe posed by the Rashists compelled



progressive nations to support Ukraine's submission to exclude Russia from the United Nations Human Rights Council on April 7, 2022. The vote resulted in 93 countries in favor, 24 against, and 58 abstentions. No European country supported Russia, although Armenia and Azerbaijan abstained from voting.

The voting outcome was influenced by several factors:

- 1. The disregard for civilized values and the contemptuous attitude toward humanity exhibited by a significant portion of Russians.
- 2. The failure of the Rashists' military plans to capture Ukraine within 3-4 days.
- 3. The dominance of democratic world values, prioritizing spirituality, awareness, morality, empathy, patriotism, and competence over material concerns.

Ukraine's successes in combating Rashism have been made possible by:

- 1. The professionalism of the military, led by Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces of Ukraine Valerii Zaluzhnyi, the territorial defense forces, the resilience of Ukrainians, and President Volodymyr Zelenskyy's principled decision to share the fate of his people by remaining in Kyiv and working tirelessly.
- 2. Military and humanitarian aid provided by numerous countries of the civilized world.
- 3. The implementation of unprecedented political and economic sanctions by the global community, led by the United States and the United Kingdom, targeting Russian state institutions, banks, commercial entities, oligarchs, individuals, members of Vladimir Putin's family, his close associates, and state officials.

It is evident that the fight against Rashism and its consequences is a task for global civilization. Humanity must safeguard against its negative impacts on the biosphere and noosphere while working to reduce the necrosphere to create a space conducive to living in harmony with nature. This effort outlines the prospects for civilization.

By doing so, humanity will reduce collective egoism, fostering awareness and advancing its levels. At the same time, we must recognize that Rashism is a temporary phenomenon. Humanity has reached a pivotal period of self-awareness and understanding the necessity of global unity. This unity will transform the harmony of collective spiritual and intellectual resources and their creative energy into a decisive factor for evolutionary progress.

Thus, Rashists and other extremist groups will have no prospects if humanity prioritizes a value system centered on spirituality, forming a "united shield of strength" to protect true civilizational values. This means that, to prevent unprovoked aggression, higher values must always dominate the development of both interpersonal relationships and global civilizations, with material concerns being merely one of the supporting means to achieve them.




Photo 4. There is strength in unity!
